



Culbertson Rescue Squad Call to Care Scholarship

Due March 15, 2026

Culbertson Rescue believes that the future of healthcare lies in our community's youth, and their willingness to return to our community to pursue a career in healthcare.

With ongoing staffing shortages, and the lack of qualified individuals providing healthcare in rural America has never been more difficult.

Culbertson Rescue Squad will be awarding one qualified candidate \$1,000 dollars to be used towards furthering their education in a healthcare field. Applications will be reviewed by a board of members of the Culbertson Rescue Squad. Board members will not have an applicable student. If no applicant meets all criteria the most qualified individual will be selected. Candidates can be rewarded scholarship up to two times.

Eligibility:

1. Recipients must attend an accredited college or training program to pursue a degree in a healthcare discipline.
2. Recipients must have obtained a 3.0 or higher GPA for their junior and or senior (year-to-date) year of high school. College students must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA per semester to keep the scholarship.
3. Scholarship is to be awarded to one student per 12 month period. Reapplication is permitted.
4. Recipients must possess a strong character determined by extra curricular involvement, workforce history, and community involvement/volunteerism.
5. Applicants must provide high school and college (if applicable) transcripts.
