

**ALBERT G. AND BERNICE F. HANSEN
CHARITABLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

1. Applicant must be a current graduating senior.
2. Applicant must demonstrate scholastic application and intent to continue his/her education. The selection committee will also consider the applicant's financial need (are they part time employed?) along with participation/leadership in school and community activities.
3. We request the student use the Foundation's supplied form rather than a computer generated form.
4. Scholarship recipients are free to select any accredited college, university or trade school.
5. The scholarship money is to be used for direct educational expenses (i.e., tuition, fees, books and equipment). It does not include room and board. The Scholarship check will be made out to the college, university or trade school.
6. The scholarship money must be applied towards tuition within the same school year the scholarship is awarded.
7. If the student transfers to another institution of learning the scholarship money can be transferred to that school. If the student drops out of school any unused funds must be returned to the Hansen Foundation.
8. The Trustees of the Albert G. and Bernice F. Hansen Charitable Foundation will determine the number and amounts of scholarships to be awarded each year. These numbers and amounts may change annually or be discontinued entirely.
9. Recommendation of scholarship recipients will be made by the high school's selection committee to the Trustees of the Foundation, along with evidence of the recommended recipients' qualifications. The final selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the Trustees of the Foundation. A certificate will be mailed to the high school to be presented to the scholarship recipients. The scholarship registration form will be mailed directly to the student at their home address.
10. Scholarships will be given without regard to race, color, creed, religion, natural origin, sex, or employment status of prospective recipients.
11. Scholarship applications may be obtained in the counselor's office.
12. Application must be submitted by April 1, 2026 (date) to the high school's scholarship selection committee.
13. This is a one time \$4,000 scholarship presented to graduating seniors. Failure to utilize the scholarship funds in the approved manner may require the Trustees of the Foundation to recover the scholarship funds.
